Code of Conduct Policy

Students will come to the college only in approved uniform

Students are expected to maintain dignified and polite manner of behaviour with other students, Principal teachers and employees of the college

Students are expected to give their full concentration in studies, at the same time they are expected to cooperate fully in extracurricular activities/ programs organized by the college

Every student will take interest in maintaining peace, cleanliness, hygiene and safety in campus, library, laboratory, and hostel. They will not cause damage to the property of the college ie college building, infrastructure, electricity, equipment etc.

Students will not indulge in violent, terrorizing or intense activities to resolve their problems

Operation of any kind of political activity in college campus is strictly prohibited

In case of any problem students can represent the matter politely and in complete discipline before their professors or Principal or they can put up the matter to the administration through Grievance Redressal Cell or thorough Complaint Box. They should be in touch with their Teacher-Guardian instead of contacting press, media and external sources.

Students should take care that they remain free from any indictment due to immoral or serious crime. If so, action will be taken against them.

Use of unfair material during examination or attempting to do so or assisting it will be considered as misconduct, for which disciplinary action will be taken.

Smoking or consuming any kind of drugs is strictly prohibited in college campus

Attendance

As per ordinance number 6 made under Madhya Pradesh University Act 1973 regular student of the college should have 75% of attendance in order to appear in examination. This provision will be followed strictly, in case of failing the provision the student will not be allowed to appear in examination as a regular student

Ragging

As per the order of the Supreme Court dated 27/11/06 reference SLP 249/06 Kerala University against Council of the Principals and SLP number 14356/2005 ragging is a punishable crime. Ragging inside the campus, hostel or at any other place is strictly prohibited. Any Student found guilty in this Act will be rusticated from the college and strict legal action will be taken against him.

Punishment:

As per section 13 of ordinance number 7 of Madhya Pradesh University Act 1973 in case of breaking discipline inside or outside the campus there is provision of the following punishment for the guilty student:

- 1. Suspension from the classes
- 2. Rustication from the college
- 3. Losing eligibility of appearing in University/college examination
